Dear Sir or Madam,


This notice is to inform you that effective with the December 2021 billing statement, your sewer account is transitioning from the Troy Oaks service area rate to the Auburn Corners service area rate. The Troy Oaks Wastewater Treatment Plant (WWTP) has been converted to a pump station, and no longer treats wastewater from the sewer collection system in your area; the sewage is now pumped to the recently upgraded Auburn Corners WWTP at Route 44 and Route 422.

This conversion was done in order to reduce the number of County WWTPs discharging treated water into the LaDue Reservoir, and due to the prohibitive expenses associated with renovating and upgrading the decrepit Troy Oaks WWTP. The Auburn Corners WWTP service area has a higher bi-monthly sewer rate than the former Troy Oaks WWTP service area due to operating and upgrade expenses.

The new rate for your account will be \$128.88 per unit bi-monthly beginning with the December 2021 statement, and over the next few years will gradually increase until all former Troy Oaks service area accounts align with the Auburn Corners service area account rate.

The new rate for your account will be \$139.52 per unit bi-monthly beginning with the December 2021 statement, and over the next few years will gradually increase until all former Troy Oaks service area accounts align with the Auburn Corners service area account rates.
